# Spotlight Focus on Valentine's Day

Over the years, even centuries, Valentine's Day has been a religious celebration, an ancient ritual day, and a commercial holiday. All that change indicates the meaning of Valentine's Day is truly whatever you want it to be. You can skip the celebrations completely (if you're married, I would not advise this) but as Christians we cannot skip over Jesus' teachings on love.

From the Greatest Commandment, the Golden Rule, and even Jesus' prayer in John 17 it is clear that when we love one another we have finally understood Jesus' will for our lives. Let's consider two texts in the gospel of John. First, John 13:34 "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another." This is a very high calling, this exceeds "love your neighbor as yourself." This is love like Jesus does. A powerful self-sacrificing love that comes from the strength that only God can provide. How do we do this? Let's look at the second text; John 15:12-17. Here we have the same command to "love each other as Jesus has loved us." But here the command is followed by a word being repeated three times – Friends. From Jesus' words to love one another as He has loved us means to be friends.



As a Christian, make it a practice, a discipline, a spiritual goal or standard to be friends with the people you go to church with. This is Jesus' command. How does this happen? Spend time together in Church and out in the world as well. Go to Sunday School, Wednesday Night, Small groups together. Go to ball games, out for dinner, or play cards at each other's homes. To be friends is a discipline that requires doing life together. I think that is the example Jesus left us. Being friends is His teaching that He commanded us to follow.

So, Valentine's Day is very similar to Christmas in that as Charlie Brown says, "It's too commercial!" Jesus' teaching of love is anything but commercial. It is powerfully life changing. Jesus doesn't just invite you to believe in him and command you to obey him. He invites you to fall in love with him. He calls you to love his Father, just as he loves him. He offers you the Holy Spirit to empower and enable that love. Duty won't keep you from moral collapse. Obligation won't maintain your Christian behavior. Love will. Here is why we can't skip Jesus' teaching to love one another the way He loves us. The happiest day in your Christian life is when the things you ought to do are now the things you want to do because of your love for the one who first loved you.
